



Town of Waxhaw Solid Waste-Recycle-Yard Debris Tips for Disposal

Solid Waste

Household garbage and recycling are to be placed by the curb before 7 AM on your day of service. Please return your cart to your residence by 7:00 PM after service.

Recycling (Please rinse containers!)

All plastics except for #6 styrofoam/calm shells

Empty aerosol cans

Aluminum cans

Glass

Paper (Includes all papers except shredded paper)

Rigid plastics are acceptable

Milk cartons/Juice boxes

Metal food cans

Cardboard (Break down flat)

Yard Debris

Yard debris is serviced each week on Tuesday and be by the curb before 7:00 AM.

Yard debris, including leaves and grass clippings, must be in clear, plastic bags. Debris in bags other than clear will not be removed.

Limbs of any sort must be cut into 3-4 ft. lengths, bundled and tied. Limbs must be 4 inches or less in diameter in order to be removed. Limbs exceeding 4 inches in width will not be removed.

Tree trunks, stumps, root balls and firewood are not eligible for this service.

Yard waste materials created by commercial tree trimmers and/or commercial lawn care services are not eligible for removal and will not be collected.

Other

Items that **WILL NOT** be collected:

Animal waste

Tires

Rocks

Automotive parts

Carpet

Dirt

Firewood

Lumber

Stumps, roots or vines

Bricks, concrete etc,

Construction materials

Propane/oxygen tanks

Furniture

Mattresses/Box Springs

White goods (appliances) will be picked up on an as need basis. In order to schedule a pick-up of these items, you must call the Public Services Dept. to arrange for this service.
